Introduction

The policy statement sets out the School's arrangements for managing the access of providers to students at the school for the purpose of giving them information about the provider's education or training offer. This complies with the School's legal obligations under Section 42B of the Education Act 1997 and the Provider Access Legislation, January 2023.

Student entitlement

All students in Year 7-13 are entitled:

- x To find out about apprenticeships, talks and information sessions and at our annual careers fair;
- x To understand how to make applications for the full range of academic and technical courses (first key phase)
 - x two encounters for year 7-10
 - x two encounters for year 11-13

For pupils in year 12 to 13, parents will be given a reasonable amount of information about apprenticeships available during the year.
